ARE YOU CONSIDERING A MOTORING HOLIDAY IN WESTERN OR CENTRAL AUSTRALIA?

Commonwealth Railways provide special facilities and rates for the conveyance of your car between Port Pirie and Kalgoorlie or Perth and between Port Augusta and Alice Springs

General

You may rail your car, caravan, or other vehicle between the following points while you travel in the luxurious airconditioned comfort of "The Indian-Pacific," the "Trans-Australian" or the "Ghan".

Port Pirie	Kalgoorlie
Port Pirie	Perth
Port Augusta	Alice Springs

Cars are conveyed on flat wagons attached to goods trains and loading and delivery times are arranged to coincide as nearly as possible with those of the passenger train on which you travel

Petrol may be left in the tank of your vehicle.

Every care will be taken of your vehicle, trailer or caravan, but such units are conveyed solely at OWNERS RISK.

Railing your car is good sense when you consider the wear and tear which is avoided as it covers the miles "without turning a wheel"

You may leave a reasonable amount of luggage in your car whilst in transit. However, the Commissioner reserves the right to levy additional charges in respect of items which are not personal luggage. Any luggage left in vehicles is conveyed under OWNERS RISK conditions of carriage.

TRANS-AUSTRALIAN RAILWAY

Westbound

On arrival at Port Pirie you should unload your passengers and any luggage which is required on the journey, or which is to be "checked" in the brakevan, at the Port Pirie Railway Station. The driver only should then take the vehicle to the Commonwealth Railways Goods Office, (see map), between 2.00 p.m. and 3.00 p.m. for loading. Transport will be provided to return the driver to the Port Pirie Station from the car loading area.

In the westbound direction your car will be despatched from Port Pirie shortly after the passenger train and will be available at Kalgoorlie Loading Dock, east of the Railway Station along Forrest Street at 9.30 a.m. the morning after your arrival.

Vehicles consigned to Perth will be available at Kewdale at

10.00 a.m. the day after your arrival in Perth.

A courtesy car, provided by the Western Australian Government Railways, departs Perth City Station at 9.30 a.m. daily, (10.00 a.m. Saturday and Sunday), to convey the drivers of arriving motor vehicles to Kewdale.

Eastbound

Eastbound motor vehicles are loaded at the Kalgoorlie Loading Dock just east of the Kalgoorlie Station along Forrest Street, between 2.00 p.m. and 3.00 p.m. on the day prior to your departure from Kalgoorlie. Any luggage required on the train should, of course, be unloaded at your motel or placed in the cloakroom at the station prior to consigning your vehicle. On arrival at Port Pirie your car will be waiting.

Vehicles consigned from Perth to Port Pirie are loaded on

the day prior to your departure. They can be loaded at Kewdale, Avon Yard, West Merredin or Robb Jetty. Loading times vary depending on the location and the day of the week. Full details are available on application to any Commonwealth Railways Office, Tourist Bureau or Travel Agent

The concession rates apply only when the vehicle is accompanied by passengers paying not less than the equivalent of two adult first class or three adult economy fares.

Rates from Kalgoorlie to Port Pirie are the same as the rates from Port Pirie to Kalgoorlie, and rates for return journeys are double the single charges shown above.

Eastbound rates from Perth, (Kewdale), Avon Yard, West Merredin or Robb Jetty, are \$25 less in all cases than the westbound rates shown above.

Caravans and Trailers

Between Port Pirie and Kalgoorlie and vice versa caravans and trailers are conveyed only at the ordinary vehicle rates shown less an amount of \$5,00. Rates for the conveyance of caravans or trailers weighing less than 10 cwt, and for caravans and trailers to be conveyed between Kalgoorlie and Perth, are available on application.

CENTRAL AUSTRALIA RAILWAY Northbound

Vehicles are loaded at the Port Augusta Station between 10.00 a.m. and 11.00 a.m. on the day of your departure from Port Augusta. Cars are available for delivery at Alice Springs at 8.30 a.m. on the day following your arrival.

Southbound

Southbound cars must be loaded at Alice Springs before 12 noon on the day prior to your departure and will be available on your arrival at Port Augusta.
