FREIGHT RATES ON MOTOR VEHICLES

A concession in freight rates is allowed on motor cars, utilities, panel vans and station wagons, provided that the equivalent of two adult first class or three adult second class fares is paid for the same journey as the motor vehicle. From 1st August, 1965, an unloading charge of 18/6d. per vehicle, additional to freight charges, will apply at Alice Springs only.

FREIGHTING OF MOTOR VEHICLES

Passengers who so desire may arrange to have their motor vehicles carried by rail between Port Augusta or Marree and Alice Springs in either direction.

Luggage Checks

Passengers may “ check ” their luggage between any of the places at which inter-system rail tickets are on issue.

As the space available for luggage in sleeping compartments is necessarily limited, passengers are recommended to take with them in the compartment one suitcase not exceeding 28 inches in length which can be placed in the rack provided for this purpose and one smaller case (say 14-16 inches).

Other luggage should be “ checked through ” in the brakevan.

NOTE : “Through” connexions may be made in Melbourne between the “Overland” Express (between Adelaide and Melbourne) and the “Daylight” Express (between Melbourne and Sydney), thereby avoiding the stop-over in Melbourne. Full details are available from Railway Inquiry Offices.

Explanation of Abbreviations appearing in the Time Table.—E.S.T. denotes Eastern States Time, which is 30 minutes ahead of South Australian time. S.A.T. denotes South Australian Time.

RR denotes Refreshment Room at which meals may be obtained.

RR§ denotes Refreshment Room at which light refreshments only may be obtained.

Symbols denote : †† “Southern Aurora”. || “Spirit of Progress”.

† Stops when required. * Does not stop.

** The portion from Port Augusta is attached at Stirling North. (The train from Port Pirie Junction does not call at Port Augusta.)

† The portion for Port Augusta is detached at Stirling North. (The train to Port Pirie Junction does not call at Port Augusta.)

GENERAL INFORMATION

Passenger bookings may be completed at Railways Interstate Booking Offices or Tourist Bureaux.

Rail accommodation for forward journeys may be booked twelve calendar months in advance. Return rail accommodation may be booked by passengers purchasing return tickets, up to thirteen calendar months in advance.

AVAILABILITY OF TICKETS.—Ordinary tickets between Adelaide, Port Pirie Junction, Port Augusta, and Marree and Alice Springs : Single Tickets—14 days ; Return Tickets—2 months.

Ordinary inter-system tickets between other systems :

Single tickets between adjoining Systems—one month ; Single tickets between three or more Systems—three months ; Return tickets are available for six months.

Break of journey is permitted at any station, provided the journey to destination is completed within the periods above mentioned.
