FREIGHTING OF MOTOR VEHICLES

Passengers who so desire may arrange to have their motor vehicles carried by rail between Port Pirie and Kalgoorlie, from Port Pirie to Kewdale (Perth freight terminal) westbound, or from Robb Jetty or Kewdale to Port Pirie eastbound.

They are advised that the carriage of such vehicles is AT THE SOLE RISK OF THE OWNER.

Typical freight rates between Port Pirie and Kalgoorlie are:—

Tare Weight	Ordinary	Concession*
Over 15 cwt. to 25 cwt.	\$109.62	\$88.70
Over 25 cwt. to 35 cwt.	\$122.86	\$99.29

* If the equivalent of two first class or three economy adult fares is paid for the same journey.

The rates from Port Pirie to Kewdale are \$40 more, and those from Robb Jetty or Kewdale to Port Pirie are \$15 more, than the rates shown above in each instance.

C.S.T. denotes Central Standard Time which is 1½ hours ahead of Western Standard Time and 30 minutes behind Eastern Standard Time.

RR denotes Refreshment Room at which meals may be obtained. RR\$ denotes Refreshment Room at which light refreshments only may be obtained. (T) Telegrams may be received at, or dispatched from stations so marked.

AVAILABILITY OF TICKETS.—Ordinary single inter-system tickets are available as follows :—

Single tickets between adjoining Systems—one month. Single tickets between three or more Systems—three months. Return tickets are available for six months.

BOOKING OF RAIL ACCOMMODATION.—Rail accommodation for **forward** journeys to and from Western Australia may be booked twelve calendar months in advance. **Return** rail accommodation may be booked by passengers purchasing return tickets, up to thirteen calendar months in advance.

Break of journey is permitted at any station, provided the journey to destination is completed within the periods above.

Passenger bookings may be completed at Railways Interstate Booking Offices or Tourist Bureaux.

LUGGAGE.—As the space for luggage in sleeping compartments is necessarily limited, passengers are recommended to take with them in the compartment one suitcase not exceeding 28 inches in length which can be placed in the rack provided and one smaller case (say 14-16 inches). Other luggage should be presented (with rail ticket), at least 30 minutes before the train leaves, for conveyance in the brakevan.

Luggage Checks should be obtained for luggage conveyed in the brakevan. Passengers may “check” their luggage between any of the places at which inter-system rail tickets are on issue.
